

Entries must be delivered by multistate or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL. You must waive the signature requirement for delivery services, if any.

• Limit 10 entry forms per envelope.

All entries must be submitted on official AKC Agility entry forms and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC agreement are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial (AKC Rule CH 14, Sec 4). O Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. Returned check fee is \$35.00.

Only one dog per entry form; include only AKC titles on entries.

• For AKC Canine Partners, the dog's breed should be entered as "All American Dog", the listing number entered in the Registration # field, and "AKC No." box checked.

• If you would like confirmation that your entry was received before the trial has closed, please include your email address, or enclose a self-addressed stamped postcard.

O Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors.

Please check your entries! Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed.

• Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

• For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in ALL classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

• FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

• Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

• If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

• The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

CRATING

Crating will be allowed in all normal areas. Please remember social distancing when crating. Upstairs will be open for crating also.

MOVE-UPS

Move-ups (Prior to set of trials): Accepted until 6:00 pm, Monday, July 29, 2024. Move-ups (Day-to-Day): SMDTC will accept dayto-day move-ups. The request for moving up

must be made in writing at the trial site to the Trial Secretary no later than the day preceding the event.

"AFTER-CLOSING" WAITING LIST

A waiting list will be kept until Monday, July 29, 2024, 6:00 pm, to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 30 entries for each day will be placed on the wait list. Any entries received by the closing date/time that are withdrawn before the waiting list deadline will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. If an entry is cancelled but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the trials. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by the waiting list closing date will receive a full refund.

AKC JUMP HEIGHT CARDS

All dogs competing in agility **must possess** an official AKC Jump Height Card. An official AKC Jump Height Card is defined as either a permanent jump height card, a valid temporary jump height form, copies of two different measuring forms (placing the dog in the same height class) dated on or after the dog's second birthday, or copies of three different measuring forms (two of which place the dog in the same height class) on or after the dog's second birthday. All dogs without jump height cards/forms must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class; this measurement will be valid for the weekend of trials only. If a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present, all dogs without a valid jump height card/form must be measured at some time during the trial. If the dog cannot be measured by the VMO prior to running, it must be measured by the judge before its first run.

- You are not required to show your height card or send a copy with your entry.
- You are required to mark on your entry form your dog's height card status.
- It is the exhibitor's responsibility to request measurement.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds.

Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on soccer turf. Ring sizes will be 110' by 85' and 110' x 80'. Electronic timers, fully rubberized contacts and a rubberized table will be used. For your dog's safety, the majority of our jumps are keyhole type from Doggy Jumps.

New title rosettes will be awarded to all dog/handler teams finishing a title.

A MACH or PACH rosette and decorated MACH or PACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH or PACH at these trials. A PAX Rosette will be awarded to any dog finishing a PAX title at these trials. Dogs qualifying in both Master Standard and Master JWW at the same trial will receive a "Double-Q" award. Dogs Qualifying in Master FAST, Master JWW, and Master Standard will be awarded a "Triple-Q" rosette.

If you will be receiving your MACH or PACH at this trial, please notify us at **agility@smdtc.org** so we can make sure that we have sufficient awards ready.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

- TRIAL HOURS: 7:00 am to 30 minutes after end of trial.
- CRATING SPACE: Please follow social distancing when crating your dogs
- FOOD: We will have snacks available for workers only. There are several fast-food restaurants in proximity.
- **PARKING:** Free parking will be available during this show.
- **RV PARKING:** Overnight RV parking is available in the Southeast parking lot along Patterson St, not in the parking lot nearest the dome entrance.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

NO DOGS ARE PERMITTED ON ANY OF THE OUTDOOR SOCCER FIELDS AT ANY TIME.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

- The safety of dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- The Springfield MO Dog Training Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

• The Springfield MO Dog Training Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Springfield MO Dog Training Club or any official thereof.

• All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

- The Springfield MO Dog Training Club may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions, a national pandemic.
- Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds.

REFUNDS

• No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

• No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee.

- Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such the club will refund all but \$5 per day of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification of such a claim for refund by letter hand-delivered, e-mailed, or postmarked before the trial commences, and a veterinarian's letter must be provided within one week of the trial. SMDTC will partially refund entry fees, minus an administration fee that will also include recording and judge's fee, of any dog that has become injured or ill after the closing date of the trial and cannot compete.
- No refund will be issued for overpayment of \$12.00 or less.

RINGSIDE

- Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.
- Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Exhibitor of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

THE RING

Exhibitors may place leashes in their pockets or wear them when running the course. Leashes must fit fully in pocket (per AKC). We highly recommend this method be used.

The club will be using the agility gate app. Code will be sent in confirmation letter.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDA NCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN THIS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24 - choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and <u>may not</u> compete in a jump height division <u>higher or lower</u> than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of

record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
