#### **Online Entries**

#### "After Closing" Waiting List

A waiting list (25 runs maximum each day) will be maintained from closing until Monday, October 7, 2024, 6:00 pm CDT. Any dogs that are entered in these trials at closing and pulled before the waiting list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by dogs in order on the waiting list, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. If a dog is pulled but cannot be replaced the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the trials. Entry fees for dogs on the waiting list that do not get into the trial by the waiting list closing date will be refunded in full.

#### **Dogs Eligible to Enter**

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the AKC Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

#### Prizes and Awards Standard, JWW, Premier, FAST, and Time 2 Beat:

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs qualifying in each jump height class. Ribbons will be awarded for  $1^{st} - 4^{th}$  place finishes in each jump height class. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. New Title rosettes will also be awarded to dogs finishing a new title at these trials. AGCH, MACH, and PACH ribbons and bars will be awarded to any dog finishing an AGCH, MACH, and PACH title at these trials.

## SITE INFORMATION

The trial will be held in an indoor packed dirt arena. 1 ring, 80' x 122' in size will be used. *Crating* space will be available. There will be a food concession at the trial site. There are several restaurants and fast food places within driving distance.

### **Trial Information**

The building will be open Friday morning, October 18, 2024, for course building. Times will be announced after closing. Volunteers who assist in setting up the rings may set up their crates after course building is completed. Trial hours are: Friday, October 18, 2024, 12:00 pm to 30 minutes after the completion of judging. Saturday/Sunday, October 19/20, 2024, 7 am to 30 minutes after the completion of judging.

The Livestock Center is climate controlled. It does have indoor restrooms and bleacher seating. Please bring crates, water for your dogs, and clean up supplies. X-pens will be allowed for 2 or more dogs but should be restricted to the minimum size required for crating.

## Notice to Exhibitors

\*The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

\*<u>Entry fees</u> will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee or the judge. Capitol Canine Training Club may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.

\*Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the Event Committee.

\*Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete in this trial the club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for this reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification of such a claim for refund by letter hand-delivered, emailed, or postmarked before the trial commences.

<u>\*The club</u> will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee per day for <u>injured or ill dogs</u>. A written request for a refund must be made to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the first trial day and a veterinarian's letter must be provided within one week of the trial.

\*It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case no refund of any fees paid will be made. \*All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

\*Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Capitol Canine Training Club has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required. Failure to be at the ring gate could result in the exhibitor being marked absent.

\*Entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must complete the back of the form. \*Include only AKC titles on the form.

\*Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. \*Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries. Capitol Canine Training Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

#### <u>\*Returned</u> checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a <u>\$25 returned check fee</u>. \*No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than <u>\$12</u>.

\*No checks will be returned if an entry is cancelled. Checks will be shredded.

\*Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

\*No un-entered dogs are permitted within the Livestock Center.

\*Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials. \*All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit this event are vested with Capitol Canine Training club, or persons to whom the assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. Photographs and/or video recordings taken for any reason other than personal use are strictly prohibited.

\*No Solicitation permitted on the trial site.

\*Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

\*No laser pointer devices allowed in the show site building.

FIX AND GO ON (FNG) Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not preentered; rather, it occurs during a run.

FEO (For Exhibition Only) will be allowed at this trial. Please see Chapter 5, Section 7 of the AKC rule book regarding rules for FEO.


#### NOTE: Some motels may charge a pet fee or have limits on size.
