During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 165 runs online (50%), 165 runs paper (50%) each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

Paper entries received within the first 24 hours must include postage or be metered and must be delivered by multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL. You must waive the signature requirement for delivery services, if applicable.

Limit of 10 dogs per envelope. No hand deliveries can be accepted in the first 24 hours. No FAX or emailed entries accepted.

All entries must be submitted on official AKC Agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC Agreement are not acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are not acceptable.

If you would like confirmation that your entry was received before the trial has closed, please include your email address or enclose a self-addressed stamped postcard.

Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed. Please check your entries!

“After Closing Waiting List”

A waiting list will be maintained for these trials once they have closed on Friday August 23, 2024. The waiting list will be active until its deadline – Monday, September 2, 2024 at 6:00pm CST. Any runs that are entered in these trials at closing and pulled before the waiting list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by runs in order on the waiting list, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. If a run is pulled but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the run. Entry fees for runs on the waiting list that do not get into the trial by the waiting list closing date will be refunded in full.

Move-ups

For the Friday trial: MOVE-UPS close at 6:00 pm CST, Monday, September 2, 2024.

Move-ups may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your entry, an email confirmation of the move-up will be sent.

For the Saturday and Sunday trials: MOVE-UPS close 30 minutes after the end of the trial on Friday and Saturday, respectively and must be submitted at the trial.

Change of Entry

As described in Chapter 1, Section 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, a dog which is entered in a Novice A class for which it is not eligible may be moved to Novice B. In addition, after the close of entries a dog may be moved down in their class level (ie Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

After the close of entries, a dog may be moved down in their class level (ie Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

If a VMO or Field Representative measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run in any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement form when requesting the class change.

Obstacles

Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. Contacts are rubberized.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

These trials are open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registrations, or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Dogs with a PAL/ILP number or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog’s physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Wherever the word “dog” is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

Prizes and Awards

Ribbons will be awarded to First Place through Fourth Place in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons.

A jump bar and MACH rosette will be awarded to any handler finishing a MACH title at these trials. A jump bar and PACH rosette will be awarded to any handler finishing a PACH title at these trials. There will be an AGCH rosette for any handler finishing an AGCH title.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Mats are required under crates and chairs in the annex
- There is a \$10.00 fee for any spills on the matting payable to ASDS
- Battery operated fans only in the crating area
- **No foot traction spray (Show Foot, Firm Grip, etc) is allowed at this facility**
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competitions by action of the Event Committee.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, and act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- There will be no seating for spectators in the main building. Only dogs lined up to run may be near the entry/exit.
- Bitches in season are not allowed to compete in AKC Agility Trials. Refunds for bitches that come in season and injured dogs after the closing date, will receive a refund minus \$18.00 per day with a veterinary statement.
- All dogs **must be on leash or crated at all times** except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee.
- **There will be a \$20 fee for any dogs that soil the turf or equipment payable to the facility**
- No refunds will be issued for overpayment of \$10 or less.
- Checks for canceled entries will be shredded; no check will be returned.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making our entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Failure to be at ring gate could result in the exhibitor being marked absent.
- Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must enter their JH# and complete back of form. Include only AKC title on entries.
- Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.
- Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of the requirement.
- Electronic timing will be used at these trials
- The building and crating annex are climate controlled. **Do NOT** adjust the thermostats.
- Flexi-leads will not be allowed in the building.
- Dogs may not be left in the building overnight.
- Please bring crates, water and clean up after your dogs.
- Snacks and water will be provided for **workers**
- **Please be respectful of your fellow exhibitors & dogs at all times, including if your dog barks excessively and/or lunges at their kennel door. If kenneling in the annex, cover crates, put your chair in front of the kennel. If crating outside, cover crates, park away from heavy foot traffic areas around the annex & arena or position vehicle so the dog cannot see the majority of foot traffic. If barking/lunging occurs you may be asked to move.**

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered at any level (Novice, Open Excellent or Masters) in FAST, JWW, Standard or Premier classes. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.
- Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, JWW, Standard, Premier and ISC will be 45 seconds. FAST courses times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations.

Directions

Please be aware that some navigation devices do not know the location for All Star Dog Sports! Enter the address as printed in the premium carefully. It is advised that you look at a map and find the location before trusting your phone or GPS.

The site is located south of the city of Blue Springs on Highway 7. It is just south of the intersection of Hwy 7 and Wyatt Rd on the west side of Hwy 7.

If you are coming from the north (I-70), it is 4.8 miles south of the intersection of Hwy 7 and I-70 immediately past Anderson Rentals, which is at the intersection of Hwy 7 and Wyatt Road.

If you are coming from the South, it is 1.4 miles north of the intersection of Hwy 7 and Colbern Rd or 5.3 miles north of the intersection of Hwy 7 and Hwy 50, north of LockBox Storage.

Hwy 7 is divided by a median so it will be necessary to drive north of the site and make a U-turn at Wyatt Rd

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
