Move Ups:

Move ups will be allowed prior to the start of this trial until 6:00 PM of Monday, March 3, 2025. Mail and E-mail changes will be accepted until that date. Day to day move ups at the trial will also be accepted. Forms will be available on site and must be completed and submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes following the close of the days competition.

After close wait list: A waiting list (30 runs per trial) will be maintained for these trials after the trial has closed on Friday, February 21, 2025 at 5:00 PM. The waiting list will be active until Monday, March 3, 2025 at 6:00 PM. Any dogs that aren't entered in these trials at closing and pulled before the waiting list closure will be replaced; if possible, by dogs in order on the waiting list, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. If a dog is pulled but cannot be replaced with an entry from the wait list, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the trials. Entry fees for dogs on the waiting list that do not get into the trial by the waiting list closing date will be refunded in full.

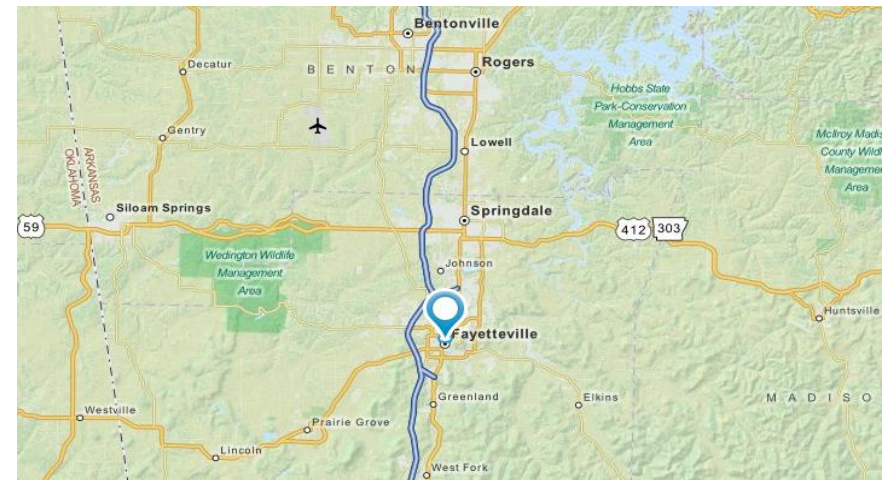

CHECK IN - HEIGHT CARDS

EFFECTIVE January 1, 2010 When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. **It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.**

CLASS CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2020

Effective January 1, 2020 exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entering in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working toward their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular or both Preferred on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted with the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend, thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form has been filled out. In other words, the first run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

All owners/exhibitors should be aware that the entire motel and grounds are considered within the trial limits. Prizes and Awards

Ribbons will be awarded to 1st through 4th place in each jump height in each class. A qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. Dogs must qualify to receive a placement ribbon. New Title prizes, Double Q ribbons, and MACH Ribbons will also be available.

Obstacles

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

Handlers entered in all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of the class; The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

Notice To Exhibitors

- **NORTHWEST ARKANSAS AGILITY GROUP does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth in the AKC official entry form for this event.**
- Telegraph, telephone, and fax entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms or entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Unsigned Entry Forms cannot be accepted or entries which specify any conditions as to its acceptance.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- NORTHWEST ARKANSAS AGILITY GROUP and its agents, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- NORTHWEST ARKANSAS AGILITY GROUP and its agents, etc, reserve the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against NWAAG.
- Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be returned if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A \$35.00 service fee will be added for all returned checks.
- No refund for duplicate entries. Care will be taken to find duplicates; however, if an entry has been processed **No Refund** will be made.
- Owners are responsible for errors made in completing entry forms. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors. If an exhibitors error causes a cancellation of an entry no entry fee will be refunded if the cancellation is after the published closing date. **PLEASE PRINT OR TYPE CLEARLY.**
- All dogs present must be on leash or confined to crates or ex-pens when not being judged, except when in the designated warm-up area.
- It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such a case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.
- The club will provide **full refunds less processing fees** for bitches in season, injured or sick dogs. A request for refund and written verification from a veterinarian must be

submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the trial. Refunds will be mailed after trial.

- Bitches in season are NOT allowed on the trial grounds.
- Exhibitors may choose to enter their dog in a higher height division than required by AKC, but not a division lower than their AKC mandated height.
- Exhibitors may not enter the building until the designated time given with final confirmation or they are subject to being excused from the trial and no refund given.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. NORTHWEST ARKANSAS AGILITY GROUP and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards for the purposes of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
- This trial will be run under the revised Regulations for Agility Trials that became effective as of January 3, 2024.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.
- Crates may be left in the area designated for agility for the duration of the trial. NORTHWEST ARKANSAS AGILITY GROUP and the University of Arkansas assumes no responsibility for anything lost or stolen.
- No dogs may be left at the trial site overnight.
- Crating in the lobby area is for Trial Committee members only.
- The trial will be held indoors on 2 92 x 90 packed dirt surfaces.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Anyone in violation of a restriction pursuant to AKC rules or policies, or the law can be asked to leave the grounds. If the person fails to leave, the local authorities will be contacted. In addition, if the club believes laws, restrictions, or conditions of release are being violated by an individual's attendance or participation in AKC events, the local authorities will be contacted immediately as they have the authority of enforcement.

Dogs Eligible To Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC PAL/ILP number. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under 4 months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

Owners are responsible for entering their dogs in the proper height division. Exhibitors may choose to enter their dog in a higher height division than required by AKC, but not a height

division lower than the AKC mandated height. Judge reserves the right to measure dogs entered at the Trial.

NEW AKC SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2022

The AKC will address all social media complaints, regardless of where the post is made or the content of the post, via the Code of Sportsmanship and Code of Sportsmanship Enforcement Policies (both are available [here](#)). Event Committees are not to entertain complaints regarding the content of a social media post. Exhibitors should contact the Compliance Department (compliance@akc.org or 919-816-3546) for questions about how to file such a complaint.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

For Exhibition Only may be offered each day at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay the class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as a part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler may declare the day of the show.

Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

Dogs may be entered at any level (Novice, Open, Excellent, or Masters) in FAST, JWW, Standard, or Premier classes. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.

Course time for FEO in T2B, JWW, Standard, Premier, and ISC is 45 seconds. FAST course times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations.

FEO is noted as NT on the scribe sheet and as ABSENT in the catalog for all dogs, all classes.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered, rather it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on the course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

If you do not receive a confirmation email within several days of submitting your entry, first check your spam folder. If you don't find your confirmation in your spam folder then contact the trial secretary.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners ProgramSM may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your

number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
